
Parent issues raised / feedback given

The comments below were made by parents. Comment by professionals are given in italics.

- How can we feedback to the SEND workshop if we can't attend?
- No contact with STAR Team
- Can't get a hold of the STAR Team
- STAR Team case worker very rarely available to return calls, very frustrating
- Local offer would be helpful to know if an activity is appropriate for children with autism
- Parents need to know if adequate resources exist. If they don't, parents can fight for more.
- Having problems with Penderels Trust (speak to social care)
- pinpoint Autistic Spectrum events leaflets more please
- Local offer and other information make eligibility criteria clear from the start (will look at adding to Local Offer)
- Age specific activities physical age of child might be too old, but not mental age
- Service aren't equally spread across Cambridgeshire, often nothing in Fenland
