Special Needs Community Information Point (SCIP)

SCIP is for families with 0-19 year olds with a disability or additional needs.

Through SCIP you will receive:

- information on activities and support
- news and events
- support network - request information specific to your family's needs via telephone or email
- the SCIP card - produced for families who on occasion need assistance while out with their child, especially where the condition is not visibly evident, or when a child is reacting to a situation, such as loud noises, or is in an uncomfortable situation and reacting in a way that draws attention.
