

Your child or young person doesn't need a diagnosis for you to seek Pinpoint's help or attend one of our sessions. They may be on a waiting list, accessing services, had a referral turned down, or just be struggling.

We can signpost you to relevant organisations and services, and tell you where to go for help and advice.

We also hold **free** workshops and events with professional speakers and specialists.
